KEEP KIDS FOUND Children account for 13 percent of lost hikers. Dress kids in bright colors to keep tabs on them, tell a child to stay put (hug a tree) if they feel lost, give them a whistle necklace, and teach them to make an emergency poncho from a trash bag.

Lost If a hiker is reported missing, there's a 68 percent chance he's lost. Learn how to stay oriented and on-track, and get out alive.
